Yr13: A levels and Vocational level 3 qualifications (13th August)

Results can be collected from **8:00am** in school. They will be available in the Sports Hall where staff are available for support and advice regarding UCAS, university, college, careers and the exam board Post-Results services. Alternatively, you can ring school after 11:00am to receive your results. Results can be posted to students if we receive a stamped addressed envelope before Monday 10th August.

Yr12: AS levels and Vocational level 3 qualifications (13th August)

Results can be collected from **10:00am** in school. They will be available in the Sports Hall where staff are available for support and advice regarding progression into Year 13 and the exam board Post-Results services. Alternatively, you can ring school after 11:00am to receive your results. Results can be posted to students if we receive a stamped addressed envelope before Monday 10th August.

Yr11: GCSEs and Vocational level 1/2 (BTEC) qualifications (20th August)

Results can be collected from **9:00am** in school. They will be available in the Sports Hall where staff are available for support and advice. They will be an opportunity to discuss and review your post 16 options and pathways support. Alternatively, you can ring school after 9:30am to receive your results. Results can be posted to students if we receive a stamped addressed envelope before Monday 10th August. **6th Form Induction Day (Yr12) begins Thursday 3rd September.**

Yr10: Unitised module scores/grade (20th August)

These are not certificated results but count towards qualifications in 2027. Yr10 students will receive an automated email to their Hwb Outlook email account notifying them of their unit scores/grade for exams this summer. These will be fully explained in the email. If students and parents wish to collect their Yr10 unitised scores/grades they will be available in the Sport Hall from 11:00am where staff are available for support and advice.
